## **Starting School Times**

All new pupils starting Reception will have a staggered intake for their first experience of school:

#### Mornings only

10 new children starting mornings each day from Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2020.



#### 8.50am-11.30am

For your child's first couple of sessions the timings are:

#### 8.50am-Specific starting time

We are unable to offer our 8.40 am 'soft start' due to our staggered start times across the school.

Wednesday 9th September:

10 children will attend for the morning

Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> September:

10 children from the previous day <u>plus</u> 10 new children will attend for the morning

Friday 11<sup>th</sup> September:

20 children from the previous 2 days <u>plus</u> 10 new children will attend for the morning



#### **Welfare Matters**
