



We thought you would find it useful to have information about some of the work that your child will be doing in Year 2 this term. The class teachers have prepared the information below which will enable you to support your child at home as well.

In Year 2 this term, your child will be learning about:

<p>ENGLISH</p>	<p><u>Fiction:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recounts of personal experiences and those of others (both real and fictional) - diary writing. <p><u>Non-Fiction:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recounts - personal experiences and those of others real and fictional • Information texts. <p><u>Poetry:</u> Poems on a theme</p> <p><u>Grammar - Revision of previous year and:</u> Use of capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks to demarcate sentences, formation of nouns using suffixes such as <i>-ness</i>, <i>-er</i> and by compounding [for example, <i>whiteboard</i>, <i>superman</i>]. Key terminology for pupils: noun, noun phrase, statement, question, exclamation, command, compound, adjective, verb, suffix, adverb, tense (past/present), apostrophe, comma.</p> <p><u>Spelling</u> Revision from previous year and an introduction to new work and statutory requirements as laid out in the new National curriculum for English (please see school website).</p>

- Please help your child to learn his/her spellings. See the website for year 2 lists. Extra spellings to learn will be sent home from time to time.
- Encourage and give help with any weekly homework .
- Practise of number bonds - e.g. $10+0=10$, $9+1=10$ etc, times tables 2, 5 and 10, adding and subtracting, especially mental work. Counting out money and giving change.
- Read and enjoy a wide range of books.
- Visit places of interest - e.g. the park.
