PARENT/CARER CURRICULUM INFORMATION SHEET

TERM: AUTUMN 2021

We thought you would find it useful to have information about some of the work that your child will be doing in Nursery this term. Your child may have already covered some of these outcomes at their previous settings, however it is very important to us to establish a clear starting point which we will use to adequately plan provision that your child needs for their ongoing development.

The context for learning this term will be 'All about me'. Please see the Nursery external door each week for further curriculum information and key reminders.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT	<p>We will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Separate from our families and come into Nursery independently • Play alongside others and form relationships • Independently explore the new learning environment • Seek support or guidance from adults and others around us • Learn about our rules, routines and expectations in Nursery.
PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT	<p>We will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use a range of equipment to develop gross motor skills such as kicking a large ball or using jugs to pour • Using the outdoor space to practice balancing and climbing • Hold mark making equipment so we can begin to write our name • Become independent with our self-care (e.g. - toileting independently, helping with dressing).
COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE	<p>We will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen to and join in with various stories and rhymes • Recognise and respond to familiar sounds • Use language to share our thoughts, feelings and experiences • Follow simple instructions (e.g. - put toys away) • Ask questions.
LITERACY	<p>We will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Show an interest in books • Repeat words and phrases from familiar stories • Explore early mark making and begin to give meaning to the marks we make • Begin to write our name.
MATHEMATICS	<p>We will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recite some number names in sequence • Organise objects into categories (e.g. - putting all the blue teddies together) • Compare different quantities • Notice shapes in the environment and in pictures/illustrations.
UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD	<p>We will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Imitate everyday actions from our experiences and family life, in pretend play (e.g. - cooking in the kitchen) • Explore, observe and talk about things that happen in our lives • Establish friendships • Become aware of the festivals of Diwali and Christmas • Play with small world models such as the farm or train track.
EXPRESSIVE ARTS & DESIGN	<p>We will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Join in with singing familiar and new songs • Explore instruments, how they are played and the sounds they make • Experiment with colour and marks • Make believe by pretending • Use representations to communicate such as, drawing a line and saying "That's me".
