What is pupil premium?

Pupil premium is additional funding for schools to support children’s learning and wellbeing. It helps us provide extra resources, enrichment opportunities, and targeted support.

Who can apply?

You may be eligible if you receive any of the following:

- universal credit
- income support
- jobseeker’s allowance
- child tax credit (without working tax credit)
- other qualifying benefits



Why it matters:

even if your child doesn’t take free school meals, applying helps the school access vital funding to support their education.

It’s quick and confidential.

PUPIL PREMIUM IS MORE THAN JUST FREE SCHOOL MEALS

You may be eligible for pupil premium if you are in receipt of certain welfare benefits. If you think you may be eligible, you can run an online check at <https://pps.lgfl.org.uk/> or alternatively you can contact the school office
