PICK 2 TASKS PER HALF TERM

SCIENCE

Research an animal and create a fact file about its life cycle.

HISTORY

Design an early aeroplane (can be drawn or 3D) in the style of the Wright brothers.

PE

Design your own dance and record it with the theme 'explorers'. Think about a range of movements.

GEOGRAPHY

Design a postcard for a seaside town in the UK.

PE

Create your own warmup- record a clip to show how we can warmup our body before exercise.

DT

Research wheels and axles. You could create a fact file, draw and label a diagram or even make a vehicle.

MUSIC

Use household objects to create a pitch pattern-a group of different high and low sounds.

SCIENCE

Create a poster with information about what humans need to survive.

RE

Make a leaflet or poster about a place, or places, of worship. Include information about what special things can be found inside and what people do there.

The tasks that require writing or drawing have been highlighted in yellow. Photographs or videos of your child completing the task can be sent to teachers. If your child is using a device to research or take a photo/video, please ensure they are supervised.
